DIRECTIONS

From I5 heading north or south – Take exit 253 for OR-22/OR-99e toward Stayton/Detroit Lake (0.2 mile). Merge onto Mission St. SE headed west toward downtown Salem (2.6 miles). Turn right at Capitol St. SE. Watch for parking signs.

From HWY 22, Coast or West Salem – Take Dallas Coast Hwy/OR-22 to Front Street exit (1.2 miles; Front St. becomes Trade St. SE and then Bellevue St. SE). Turn right at 12th St. SE (394 feet). Turn right at Oak St. SE (0.1 mile). Turn left at Capitol St. SE. Watch for parking signs.
